

Eligibility

Students who meet the following criteria are eligible for the scholarship.

The UncommonGoods Scholarship Program is open to students who are at least 16 years of age in the United States and on-track to apply for or are currently enrolled in an accredited post-high school/post-secondary educational program (including accredited two and four-year college, universities). UncommonGoods, LLC reserves the right to verify eligibility requirements in any manner we deem appropriate.

Application

The scholarship is awarded once per semester and twice a year.

The first application period begins on April 1st at 12:00 a.m. Eastern Standard Time ("EST") and the deadline to apply is July 15th at 12:00 a.m. Eastern Standard Time ("EST").

The second application period begins on September 1st at 12:00 a.m. Eastern Standard Time ("EST") and the deadline to apply is December 15th at 12:00 am Eastern Standard Time ("EST").

The following materials should be submitted:

- Completed application
- A short paragraph addressing the prompt given in the guidelines
- Uploaded photos of design or art work

Selection Process

Selections of winning submissions are entirely at the discretion of UncommonGoods's selection panel. The winner will be contacted via the email address used for submission from scholarship@uncommongoods.com.

Recipients will be selected by an UncommonGoods selection panel based on application materials provided. All scholarship winners will be notified of the committee's decision by August 5th (1st application period) or January 5th (2nd application period).

Award

Payment will be made to the recipient's school upon notification and in accordance with the school's scholarship guidelines.

A \$1000 prize will be awarded to one student each semester. Two prizes will be awarded each year.

Submission Content
